2. Update on Bylaws (Judge Osborne/Michael Stout)

Stout- Moves to adopt draft as bylaws of council.

Judge Joy Goldbaum will 2nd approval of bylaws.
Judge Cano, page 2, number 3, should be 31-28-3.

Cano- does anyone oppose. ***Bylaws approved.***

Stout- suggests that so called voting members approve all other non-voting members

3. Pre-trial Detention (Michael Stout)- A committee formed from last meeting
Going to ask Chairman Cano, would like a member from magistrate court.
Tanika would be happy to give information from around the country.

4. Upcoming Grant (Mike Tapia). Mr. Tapia not present. Stacey Madson, he is
working on grant, similar to specialty court. Post prison release.

5. Mental Health Summit (Stacey Madson) Chief Justice Nakumara will be
holding a mental health summit 4/15 to 4/17. Want to bring stakeholders
throughout the state. Each court with a team of 5-8 individuals. No
registration fee. All meals included but each team member responsible for
their own travel and lodging costs. At Buffalo Thunder \$131 per night. At
discretion of Chief Judge Arrieta as to who will be on team. Himself, Judge
Duffin, County Manager Macias and Jaime Michael.

6. Juvenile Possession Charges (Richard Johnson/Bernice Ramos). New de-
criminalization for marijuana for juveniles. JPO has still been receiving
referrals and been processing them. 99% are handled informally. Had a
meeting with Judge Duffin and Judge Duran last week. They have only
received 3 or 4 at magistrate court. All other districts are still class III.
