Amendment #2: Eliminate Article 5 (Executive Committee) – not required by statutes or the Act – and allow for designation of subcommittees by Presiding Judge.

Amendment #3: Amend Article 11 to state: “Meetings of the CJCC and its subcommittees will generally follow Robert’s Rules where necessary. The Rules can be modified by a majority of the voting members.”
