6. Review October Minutes-  
Judge Osborne moves adoption,  
Chief Lara 2nds  
Chair adopts minutes
7. Pretrial Detention (Michael Stout)-Recommends we have a committee for pretrial services to see how it can work more efficiently and to show how it can improve.

Judge Cano- Asked Mr. Stout to chair that committee. Mr. Stout would be happy to chair. Need to decide on how many committee members would be needed.

D. Borunda- Informs everyone that he has been to conferences, money coming. Mr. Stout welcomes that.

Chief Arrieta- Start forming committees, See was issues there might be. Anyone that finds this interesting recommends for him or her to get involved.

Judge Perea-Committee can provide great guidance, bracelets, check ins. Committee would be ideal but would not be able to serve due to conflict.

D. Borunda-Money coming to the Third. Kelly Bradford would come down to help with process.

Mr. Stout-Recommends that one (1) week from today to find a group to work on process of improving pretrial services.

Judge Cano-asked if anyone had questions.

Mr. Sewell- Recommends a police agency being on committee.

8. District Court Warrant issues (Judge Conrad Perea)-District Court takes the calls, Judge Perea has never refused a call. He still averages five (5) calls a week even when he is not on call. Arrest/Search warrant procedure has been put in place. Judge Perea is ready to share the wealth.

D. Borunda-If unable to find a judge for warrants, David or Stacey will find one.

Chief Judge Arrieta-Has asked Judge Perea to create a guideline for the procedure because he's well versed. If unable to reach a Judge, please let him know. Gives examples as to why a Judges might not be able to answer. They might be on the bench and unable to answer, if that happens come to the Courthouse to get warrant signed.

Goldbaum- Asks that someone send her the process that Judge Perea drafted.

Judge Cano- will have Bernice distribute the process to everyone.

Patrick Buksath NMSP- some cases do not go federal for several months; they don't have immediate knowledge if it's going federal. 1<sup>st</sup> Degree/Capital goes to District Court.

Judge Cano- Asks if there are any other questions

Patrick Bucksath NMSP- Thanks Judge Perea. Training has always been to go to District Court for search warrant. Other issues on search warrant being thrown out.

Judge Madrid- not supposed to help law enforcement. Now allowed to give legal advice, only review or refer to Assistant District Attorney.

Patrick Bucksath NMSP- not asking for assistance.

Mr.Sewell- disagrees that it will become political issue

Judge Cano- gets back on track due to time.
