Stout: needs more data/time before making changes. Does not have the data to make suggestions and will provide more information once they have more data.

3. Approval of CJCC of Non-Voting Members

Stout - don't have approval of voting members by Judge Arrieta - can't approve non-voting members without approval of voting members

Sergeant Ramos - questions about how many members from each group are allowed
Judge Arrieta - people can motion to be made voting members

Judge Cano - Want to establish voting members first, then do non-voting members after that. If an agency wants to establish voting members then they need to send the name of that individual to Bernice
