2. Honorable Chief Judge Conrad Perea, Third Judicial District Court

- a. *Third Judicial District Court Investiture Ceremony for the Honorable Mark D. Standridge on May 19, 2023 at 3 pm*
 - i. The court will be closed at 2 pm for the investiture of Judge Standridge

 - i. Judge Perea plans on being more involved and hands on
 - ii. Michael Stout asks about status of case management order from Supreme Court
 - 1. Judge Perea: the Supreme Court hasn't decided on local rule yet, but it is very much wanted and they have been waiting on it. Judge Perea anticipates that it will come soon.

3. Denali Wilson, Staff Attorney, ACLU of New Mexico

- a. *Request for membership on the CJCC*
- b. *Request for CJCC's Endorsement of (De)serving Life's Application for Crime Reduction Grant*
 - i. Michael Stout: moves for approval of grant request
 - ii. Denali Wilson: (De)serving Life wants to be a member

a. Treatment Court Utilization Issues

- i. Sheriff Stewart: asks when providing services through treatment court, what providers are they using?
- ii. Priscilla Camunez: there are 5 treatment courts
- iii. Judge Perea: doesn't see referrals to treatment court in plea deals very often. It would be great if the defense and prosecution could add this to negotiated plea.
- iv. DA Byers: not opposed to utilization of treatment courts.
- v. Priscilla Camunez: they are working with the DA's office and their PPD regarding new referrals
