## 2. Kristofer Knutson, Law Offices of the Public Defender

- a. *Expungements under the Cannabis Regulation Act*
  - i. Topic now moot, but was concerned because there are new expungements filed with objections. The Public Defender's office is concerned because not everybody was aware of the act and they did not receive copies of the objections that were filed. There was a deadline to respond and they didn't get served.
  - ii. David Borunda: several objections sent to district court by the District Attorney's office. These cases are getting filed, but not sure how far they have advanced.
  - iii. Gerald Beyers: There is a lot of confusion statewide regarding the process with two different lists circulating that are confusing the process. The DA's office will be withdrawing the objections filed and clean up the process so time is not wasted.
  - iv. Sheriff Stewart: did law enforcement have an opportunity to respond to any objections?
    1. Gerald Byers: the statute did not include an option for input from law enforcement.

- La Casa: wants to start a conversation about the Batterer's Intervention Program. The referrals are decreasing, and they will present at the next meeting.
- Jackie Douglas: reminder that the judges will be at conclave and will only have video arraignments.
- Kristofer Knutson: the backlog presented by Supreme Court is primarily contract attorneys, and there will be case management orders coming soon.
