a. Report on CJCC in Albuquerque

- i. Many grant requests being approved for funding
- ii. Send questions to the New Mexico Sentencing Commission – nmse@unm.edu, nmse.smapply.io for questions; or if they have a project that needs funding
- iii. National standards for CJCCs developed over the course of one year on a national level
 - 1. Example: want CJCCs to consider a vision and mission statement and to review bylaws on a continuum to garner more membership
 - 2. Also want CJCCs to consider identifying and appointing officers that serve the CJCC that will develop and identify an executive committee
 - 3. Would also like a program coordinator

a. Third Judicial District Court and Dona Ana County Magistrate Courts Closure on Friday, June 30, 2023, from 2 pm to 5 pm

c. Appeals filed in Magistrate Cases

- 1. Bonds are not being posted by individuals who are appealing a magistrate's decision on a CV case; appeals are going forth without bond being posted; this creates a delay in an eviction; Judge Perea looking into this delay of posting of bonds before an appeal can be heard; should not be hearing an appeal without a bond being posted

- d. LR – Case Management Rule/Order – “Local Rule 3-303” – has copy of rule and request to hold meeting with DA/PD and judges who hear criminal cases with Chief Justice Michael Vigil on Friday, May 19, at 11 am; Judge Perea will send copy of rule

- e. Judge Perea has found inconsistencies between December document and this final document; this Friday will be an opportunity to voice those concerns and point out inconsistencies

- 5. **Scott Patterson, AOC Statewide Behavioral Health Manager**
 - a. **Request for CJCC’s Partnership on Cross System Pilot Application to NM Sentencing Commission**
 - i. Would like to have a pre-evaluation competency diversion program; would like to have an agreement with the PDs and the Das and see how those folks could be connected to services that could have them stabilized in the hopes of resolving and kind of competency issue before it’s actually raised; just in the thought process portion of it;
 - ii. Judge Cano: there is great need here in Dona Ana County for these services for those familiar faces that rotate through the system

 - a. **Dona Ana County selected as Coordinated Community Response Site**
 - b. **CCR Academy is scheduled for virtual conference on June 7th and 8th**
 - c. **Upcoming Three Day In Person CCR Academy**
 - i. DA County selected as Coordinated Community Response Site
 - ii. Three Day training will occur in fall
 - iii. Wants to ask the council if there were certain dates/months that would be preferable; looking for feedback about dates
 - 1. Judge Cano: if a certain date doesn’t work for you then email Brandi this information and let’s try to identify what days are conducive to this body so that Flor can get idea of what dates will work

Kim Stewart: letting serious felons/go through doors and come out within hours is creating a problem for agencies and costing this county quite a lot of money; something may need to be considered that some law enforcement may not want to apprehend a serious felon that is in a home; DASO is going to consider not service serious felony warrants on repeat offenders at home
