### 1. Approval of October minutes

### 2. Honorable Chief Judge Manuel Arrieta, Third Judicial District Court & Michael Stout, Private Defense Bar

- ***Proposal of Grant Subcommittee Names***
- *Judge Arrieta*: Haven't been able to work on this with Michael Stout, and nobody has sent information about who might be interested; might have to reach out and ask specific individuals to be part of the grant committee; going to reach out to Jaime Michael about Sequential Intercept Model; hoping to get some proposed subcommittee names to everybody in the next meeting
- Supreme Court has asked the Courts how they are going to handle the backlog of cases and trials. The Third Judicial District is going to say that they're doing the best that they can do and is only able to have three trials at one time until the 6-foot social distancing requirement is alleviated.
- Reiterates the importance of attendance and how these meetings have an impact on the community.
- *Michael Stout*: thinks the whole grant process is a really good opportunity for this body to try to make some progress in some discreet areas; have not had time to meet with Judge Arrieta; also ask that people show interest and give them ideas for members or show interest in membership for the grant committee; will come up with some names with Judge Arrieta -- but don't want to be left with the only option being reaching out to people and asking them to please be a member; urges people to participate or it won't work

*Judge Cano*: highlights that Chief Thornton with Hatch Police Department is attending and welcomes him

*Joel Diemer*: addresses Judge Arrieta; would the SIM group be different than the working group that he was working on?

- Judge Arrieta: it would work similarly - but need to deal with the issues that may come about with the education and training, but ultimately it's about coordinating a SIM approach towards mental health; this would work better if people would reach out and say they want to be a part of it; the next step is getting together with Joel Diemer and Michael Stout and decide if they want to reach out and bring members in

### 3. Kris Knutson, Law Office of the Public Defender

- ***Orders Revoking Probation***

- **Process**

- Having audio problems; wants to reset to fix the technology and figure out why technology makes him sound like Donald Duck

*Judge Cano:* Arrieta and Stout want five volunteers; get ahold of them if you want to volunteer

*Bryan Baker:* asks the Courts to avoid in-person transport as much as possible due to the surge of COVID cases in the community

*Robert Milks MVRDA* - a few employees are under quarantine and are very short staffed; please be patient and they are working through requests and calls as soon as they can

*Chief Ordonez* - will be mobilizing overseas for one year; police department will be eliciting a temporary chief for one year until her return

*Derek Chin-* prison population report coming out soon

*Judge Goldbaum:* directed to Bryan Baker -- defendants have a right to appear at their virtual hearing even if they're in quarantine and wants to know what to do about that situation where they're not able to appear for their hearings if they're in quarantine.

- *Bryan Baker:* will work with their staff and hopefully they can bring that person down separately; says that they should be able to accomplish that
