1. Approval of August Minutes

2. & 3: Chief Judge Manuel I. Arrieta, Third Judicial District Court and Jaime Michaels

a. Approval and Application for Grant Funding for SIM Project Database

- i. This letter will go to the New Mexico Sentencing Commission, and there needs to be a vote from the CJCC to approve a letter
- ii. Sheriff Stewart: wants to confirm that data collection does not come from law enforcement
 1. Jamie Michael: The data collection is voluntary, so it is not required. Law enforcement data is valuable, but not required. She is hoping that they will be willing to share data and they will try to make it systematic.
 2. Sheriff Stewart: they don't have an unwillingness to comply, but there is not a standard of reporting agreement. The source should be MRVDA and should be one source of data
- iii. Judge Cano: CJCC will support this letter.

3. Honorable Rebecca Duffin, Dona Ana County Magistrate Court

4. Captain Jesse Williams, New Mexico State Police

a. Issue with Warrant Approvals by On-Call Judges

- i. There have been a few instances where law enforcement has been turned to the other court when trying to get a search warrant signed; wanted to clarify instructions about warrants.
- ii. David Borunda: Judge Arrieta made an amendment to clarify this issue. He will get with Judge Arrieta to make sure that all parties have this new policy.
- iii. Judge Cano: Magistrate Court judges will never refuse a call, but it is up to individual judges. This can be added to next month's agenda.
- iv. Gerald Byers: his concerns echo that of Cpt. Jesse Williams; additional work in this area is necessary.

- v. David Borunda: he is the backup through dispatch in case law enforcement cannot contact a judge.

5. Robert Milks, Mesilla Valley Regional Dispatch Authority

a. Question on Warrants

- i. MRVDA has received warrants with no bond and the defendant to be released on OR. Certain criteria have to be met for NCIC entry, and the OR warrants do not meet this criteria and might not be eligible for entry into NCIC; needs clarification.
- ii. Judge Cano: a lot of OR warrants are not from this county and he will bring this up at the next judge's meeting. He will do what he can at the magistrate level to make sure that they're not engaging with that practice.

6. Kristofer Knutson, Law Office of the Public Defender

a. NM Sentencing Commission Crime Reduction Grant Application Vote

- i. An application for joint recruitment and retention (for both the District Attorney's and Public Defender's offices) has already been done in Bernalillo County. The purpose is to increase stability through attorney staffing. This is better for the whole system to retain attorneys.
- ii. Gerald Byers: both departments need to retain attorneys, and he strongly recommended that this initiative be approved.
- iii. Judge Cano: asks that everybody support this process.

7. Samantha Woodward, Pretrial Program Manager

a. Pretrial Services Updates

- i. Pretrial Service is missing a law enforcement individual on their Oversight Committee. Asks if anybody would be interested in serving in that capacity.
 - 1. Lt. Bradley would be more than happy to participate, and Samantha will follow up after the meeting
- ii. Data was sent out to the group for review
 - 1. Pretrial services has approximately 430 cases, and they have completed 997 intakes.

8. Flor Gonzalez, La Casa

a. BIPP Program

- i. Presentation provided by Sergio Gonzales and Alexis Villegas
 - 1. DV crimes have risen in the community
 - 2. BIPP is a 52 week program
 - 3. The main goal is to collaborate with all stake holders
